

**ORDINANCE**  
**by the Rector of the Krakow University of Economics**  
**No. R.0211.43.2025**  
from 30 July 2025

**on the rules for charging and exempting from fees for first-, second-  
and long-cycle studies at the Krakow University of Economics**

Acting pursuant to Article 23(1), Article 79(3) in conjunction with Article 79(1) and Article 324(1) and (2) of the Act from 20 July 2018. Law on Higher Education and Science (i.e. Journal of Laws of 2024, item 1571, as amended), the following is ordered:

§1

1. The rules for collecting and exempting from fees for educational services on first-, second- and long-cycle studies are established in the wording of Appendix No. 1 to this Ordinance.
2. The rules for charging foreigners for educational services on first-, second- and long-cycle studies and the rules for exempting foreigners from these fees are established in the wording of Appendix No. 2 to this Ordinance.

§2

1. The ordinance shall enter into force on the date of signing with effect from 1 October 2025, subject to paragraph 2.
2. On the date of entry into force of this Ordinance, the Ordinance of the Rector of the Krakow University of Economics No. R.0211.37.2024 from 26 August 2024 on the introduction of the Rules for collecting and exempting from fees for first-, second- and long-cycle studies at the Krakow University of Economics is repealed, with the proviso that the exemption from fees for educational services related to education in part-time studies, education in a foreign language and education of foreigners in full-time studies in Polish, for students who started their studies before the academic year 2024/2025 is determined in accordance with the rules set out in §2 section 3 of the repealed Ordinance, i.e. a student who is in at least the second year of studies and achieves outstanding academic results is exempt from these fees for the next semester of studies, provided that the fees due to the University have been paid on time, the student has been awarded credits and passed exams in the first term and that the following average grade has been obtained in the preceding semester:
  - 1) from 5.0 upwards (5.0 for students who started their studies in the academic year 2023/2024) – 100% fee exemption,
  - 2) 4.80 – 4.99 – 50% fee exemption.
